Conversation:

1. Telling someone your plan:

We're going to have a [*party*].

2. Inviting someone:

Would you like to come?
Are you free?
Can you come?
Can you make it?
It would be great if you could come?

3. Asking/telling about the time/date:

When will it be?	It's next weekend.
When is it?	Next Saturday.
When are you having it?	On Friday.
What time will it start?	At/from 7 o'clock.
When will it be?	In the evening.

4. Saying 'yes' or 'no':

Sure. I'll come. Thanks for asking me.	I'm sorry, I can't.
Yes. Thanks for the invitation.	Thanks, but I can't make it.
That sounds great.	I'd really like to, but I can't.
